Donald P. Bullock

Donald Bullock (1936-1988), a Past President and former Secretary of the ITG spent most of his professional years as professor of trumpet, and later as director of the School of Music at Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo. He was a founding member of the Western Brass Quintet. He is widely remembered for his impact as a teacher of university students and as a recognized scholar. He is also remembered for his musical and professional influence on colleagues and his exceptional leadership in the development of the ITG.
