Mathie has performed with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, The Vermont Symphony, The Potsdam Brass Quintet, and served for seven summers as solo cornetist for the Leonard Smith Concert Band. In retirement, he is still active as a theater and big band lead trumpet player. He has been honored by the State University of New York with the Chancellor's award for excellence in teaching, in addition to receiving the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Orpheus Award, and the Wayne State University Arts Achievement Award. His publications include The Trumpet Teacher's Guide, along with several etudes and transcriptions for trumpet, piccolo trumpet and Brass Quintet.
